Sebastopol General Plan Update











The City has embarked on an exciting and challenging process, an update to the General Plan. State law requires the City to periodically review and revise the General Plan. The General Plan is the City's "constitution" or "blueprint" which guides future decisions regarding land use, community design, transportation, public services, and resource conservation.

Progress Overview

The City is about two-thirds of the way through the General Plan Update. Public outreach so far has included two Visioning Workshops, a Housing and Community Services Stakeholder Workshop, online surveys, 11 meetings with the GPAC, two meetings with the Planning Commission, three meetings with the City Council, and various consultations with local agencies. The General Plan Update has produced the following documents to date, which are available on the General Plan Update website:

- o Adopted Housing Element

The Open House will provide the community with an update on the work to date and is an opportunity for the public to comment and provide input. The Open House will have stations set up focusing on the various issues addressed through the General Plan Update process (circulation/traffic, land use, economic development, habitat conservation, etc.).
